

## Checklist for Summer Fishing and Adventure Packages

Expect cool and damp overcast days with a breeze on the water - sunshine is possible!  
Temperatures range from the mid-50s to the mid-70s.

### Suggested Equipment

- Waist High, or Chest High Stocking-foot Waders with Wading shoes. NO FELT SOLED WADING SHOES! RUBBER SOLES ONLY.
- Calf-high Rubber Wading Boots for Saltwater Fishing, Kayaking, and Hiking excursions
- High Quality Rain Suit; Either Pants and Coat, or Long Coat to cover Boot tops - (Remember, SE Alaska is a Temperate Rainforest, so quality Rainwear is a must!)
- Fly Rod and Reel (Depending on your trip dates and target fish of choice, an 8 Weight Rod/Reel Combination is a good choice)
- Floating Flyline with a sinking tip to match your Rod/Reel Weight
- Small selection of Split Shot Weights
- Assortment of Brightly colored Sinking Flies; Purple Egg-Sucking Leech, Pink Hareball, Coho Shrimp, Psychedelic Zonker, and similar Pink, Purple, Chartreuse, Red, and Silver Sinking Flies for Salmon, Arctic Char, and Cutthroat. [www.alaskaflyfishinggoods.com](http://www.alaskaflyfishinggoods.com)
- Needle-Nose Pliers or Hemostat and small pair Line Clippers
- Spin-Casting Gear may be brought in addition or as an alternative to Fly Fishing Gear: Med. Action Rod/Reel combo with 12 to 15 pound test line is sufficient.
- Assortment of Brightly colored Lures and Spinners; 5/8 oz. to 3/4 oz is good - Blue Fox Pixie's in Hot Pink, Chartreuse, and Orange are good, Red/White Daredevils, and Mepps Spinners for Salmon, Arctic Char, and Cutthroat.
- Binoculars
- Fishing Pants; Polarfleece or similar material for good wicking quality and comfort inside waders
- Shirts/Sweatshirts; Polarfleece or similar material for good wicking quality and comfort ashore or on deck of the Sport-Fish vessel for the day.
- Sweater/Jacket/Vest
- Wool Socks with light-weight liner socks
- Gloves (Wool and Rubber or Neoprene)
- Billed Cap and Wool "Beanie" or "Toboggan"
- Comfortable Pant/Shirt set for relaxing aboard the vessel in the evening and when cruising
- Deck or Tennis Shoes for aboard the vessel
- Insect Repellant and Fine Mesh Headnet, Thermacell
- Camera, extra Batteries and/or Charger, Film and/or Extra Memory Chips
- Personal Toiletries and Medication
- Small Daypack or Fannypack to carry small tackle box, lunch, camera and misc. items
